Pro's Tips

Hole 1 - WIPER & TRUE - KALEIDOSCOPE (BRISTOL,UK)

A Super opening ale, Three different hops, ever changing, This is harmonious, bright and as refreshing as pale ale gets.

Hole 2 - WIPER & TRUE - MILK SHAKE STOUT (BRISTOL,UK)

The 2nd hole contains Copious chocolate malts laced with vanilla to create a luxurious, milkshake-rich dark beer. *Contains lactose.

Hole 3 - REDCHURCH BREWERY - BETHNAL PALE ALE (BETHNAL GREEN,LONDON)

An inspiring blend of English malts and American Hops, this is a big juicy fruit packed pale ale.

Hole 4 - REDCHURCH BREWERY - SHOREDITCH BLONDE (BETHNAL GREEN,LONDON)

A truly international combination of English lager malt, German yeast and a unique blend of American Hops. This a Moorish and extremely drinkable blonde lager.

Hole 5 - REDCHURCH BREWERY - BRICK LANE LAGER (BETHNAL GREEN,LONDON)

Cold fermented lager combining British lager malt, American hops and true lager yeast to create a truly crisp, refreshing beer. Pale and dry with overtones of citrus fruit with huge grassy freshness.

Hole 6 - KERNEL BREWERY - PALE ALE (BERMONDSEY,LONDON)

You never quite know what you are going to receive on a Monday morning delivery from the Kernel, the hops and malts change weekly, Only one thing is guaranteed from this phenomenal brewery and that is you are dead certain to get an amazing well made, balanced ale.

Hole 7 - KERNEL BREWERY - TABLE BEER (BERMONDSEY,LONDON)

Super light IPA full of flavoured hoppiness that never overpowers. This is an amazing session IPA that makes for a delightfully drinkable treat.

Hole 8 - LOST AND GROUNDED - RUNNING WITH SCEPTURES (BRISTOL,UK)

For this beer Lost and Grounded combine Pilsner, Vienna and Caramalts with a huge whack of hops to make what they call a Special Lager Beer. We agree we could drink this until the cows come home.

Hole 9 - LOST AND GROUNDED - KELLER PILLS (BRISTOL,UK)

Take Pilsner Malt from Germany and combine with three traditional hop varieties - Magnum, Perle and Hallertauer Mittelfruh and lost and grounded have made a clean, unfiltered, Hop Bitter Lager Beer.

Hole 10 - DE LA SENNE - TARAS BOULBA (BRUSSELS,BELGIUM)

Light blonde with 4.5% abv, generously hopped with the finest aromatic hops, giving it a very refreshing character and a scent reminiscent of citrus.

Hole 11 - DE LA SENNE - ZINNEBIR (BRUSSELS,BELGIUM)

Golden blonde with 6% abv, malty with a fine bitterness and a long aftertaste. The scent is complex, developing a fruity-hop intense fragrance.

Hole 12 - CORONA EXTRA (MEXICO)

Needs very little by way of introduction. Crisp, clean and refreshing - add a wedge of lime. Probably the easiest drinking beer on the course.

Hole 13 - CAMDEN BREWERY - CAMDEN HELLS (CAMDEN LONDON)

Hells is the lovechild of two German beer styles - Helles and Pilsner. Clean,crisp and dry. A fabulous easy drinking lager.

Hole 14 - ASAHI - ASAHI SUPER DRY (TOKYO,JAPAN)

With its refreshing barley flavour and crisp aftertaste, Asahi Super Dry is by far the most popular export from Japan - followed closely by Hideki Matsuyama.

Hole 15 - TINY REBEL BREWERY - CWTCH (NEWPORT,WALES)

Probably the best word ever. Cwtch (rhymes with butch) can mean either cuddle or cubbyhole. Grab a glass, relax and cwtch up with this untraditional Welsh red ale - a perfect blend of six "caramelly" malts and three citrusy American hops. Champion beer of Briton 2015.

Hole 16 - TINY REBEL BREWERY - BEATBOX (NEWPORT,WALES)

American Pale Ale, brewed a few hundred yards from 2010 course at Celtic Manor. There are big floral notes in this American inspired ale. A little bit of pithy fruit and a grassy nose - a classic APA.

Hole 17 - ASPALL - ASPALL DRAUGHT CYDER (SUFFOLK,UK)

Fruity, dry, racy, thirst-quenching, lip-smaking cyder from our friends at Aspall.

Hole 18 - ASPALL - ASPALL PERRONELLE'S BLUSH (SUFFOLK,UK)

Attractive apple and blackberry define a sweetish palate, with good acid balance and a long soft fruit finish. A great sweet finish to what hopefully was a successful round of golf.
